Behavioural Skills

The College of Policing provides leadership and strategic command training to international delegates, both in the UK and overseas. International leadership programmes are designed to meet the needs of individuals at operational, tactical and strategic level.

Behavioural skills programmes include:

- Strategic command course
- Training of trainers

Technical Skills

The College of Policing provides specialist serious and organised crime training, training in counter terrorism and search techniques to international delegates. This includes courses and programmes that support the development of officers and staff seeking to move into specialist roles or to provide baseline skills in investigation.

Technical skills programmes include:

- Police search advisor (PoISA)
- Counter terrorism security coordinator (CTSecCo)
- Bespoke search training

Learning Design

The College of Policing supports requests to assist in developing training design and assessment processes overseas. These are bespoke programmes designed to fit the needs of our clients and may take the form of specialist support through subject matter experts or College staff with particular skills in the following areas:
